

The Process After a Title IX Report Submission

Outreach

The Title IX Office receives a report and outreaches to impacted Parties (i.e., Complainants and/or Witnesses) with resources and a request to meet.

*Support and Resources are available at any stage of the process.

Intake Meeting

The Complainant may choose to meet with a staff member, either in person or virtually, to discuss options.

The Complainant may wish to report the matter with the intention of solely seeking resources and accommodations.

Formal Complaint

A Formal Complaint can only be filed by the Complainant or the Title IX Coordinator.

At this stage, the Respondent(s) would be notified.

Dismissal

The Complainant may request that a matter be dismissed after the intake meeting.

If the conduct alleged in a report does not fall under HOP 3-3031, it will be dismissed and may be referred to another department.
