# NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO RE-ENROLL

## PURPOSE OF FORM

This notification should be used by The University of Texas at Austin students who exited the university due to pregnancy or parenting conditions and who are ready to re-enroll. Students who leave the university for pregnancy or parenting reasons are not required to complete the Application for Admission or a Readmission Application and are not required to pay a fee. By completing this form, you are certifying that you exited the university due to pregnancy or parenting conditions.

Returning students completing this form will be enrolled in the college and program in which they were last enrolled at UT Austin. If you'd like to be admitted to a college other than the one in which you were enrolled when you left the university, please contact the Office of Admissions (undergraduate students) or the Office of Graduate Admissions (graduate students) for more information.

## TEXAS LAW

In accordance with Texas law and the Handbook of Operating Procedures 3-3021, The University shall allow a pregnant or parenting student to take a Leave of Absence for a reasonable duration as required by the circumstances. If the student is in good academic standing at the time the student takes a Leave of Absence, the student may return to the same degree or certificate program in good academic standing without being required to reapply for admission.

### **You should not complete this form if you:**

- Were last enrolled at the university as a Summer Transient student. You should complete the appropriate application for admission.
- Left UT Austin due to academic dismissal.
- Were last enrolled in the Coordinated Admission Program (CAP) or the Provisional Admission Program. You should complete the appropriate application for admission.
